This is Stan Avery, with information about the progress toward fielding van teams in India through BCM, to reach, en mass, villages which still have yet to hear the Gospel of Jesus.

With the designated funds we have received recently, BCM currently has \$7,025, set aside in account and waiting for enough funds in hand to proceed with a van purchase. The total projected cost still remains the same, of \$25,000. This would include a 12 passenger Tempo Traveler van, three projector / sound system / generator sets, ( so a large team can divide and potentially reach into three villages simultaneously ), cameras, tents, Gospel materials, taxes, insurance, etc.

BCM has a blessed superfluity of trained and motivated disciples, ready to spend themselves as full time evangelism teams in however many vans could be fielded. In my conversant relationship with the ministry in India, I would confidently say that BCM is currently able to competently staff and deploy even a hundred such vans right now. We have dedicated disciples everywhere, ministry training going on all the time, and heartbreaking lists of young disciples on waiting lists for initial and advanced ministry training, all the way from Kashmir to Sri Lanka.

In the mean time, Billy has informed me that the BCM staff is in the process of constructing detailed surveys, using the resources of government offices there, of district by district village information regarding locations and populations. After the first of the year, Billy will be traveling a lot, visiting regional pastors and putting together with them detailed map plans to thoroughly reach all villages in each area, in anticipation and preparation for when a van becomes available to send there.

Once we have about \$22,000, BCM plans to set a team in motion, by making the initial purchase and deployment of a van, so that a team can then get started on a month by month village outreach campaign. As more funds arrive, BCM will make the purchases to equip that van team with the supplies and equipment need to make their efforts far more effective. In other words, if they even get enough to just buy one van, they will drive it as far as their diesel will convey them, and walk through every village within reach, shouting out the Gospel of Jesus to everyone who can hear, until such time as they also get loudspeakers, music instruments, tracts, projectors, etc. It is always a joy and honor to work with disciples such as these, and their sacrificial fervency never ceases to amaze and inspire us.
